SUGGESTIONS & TRAVEL TIPS

- Pick a flight to arrive in Paris on Saturday around midday (so your hotel room will be ready).
- Catch shuttle bus from Charles de Gaulle airport to Montparnasse (Le Bus-direct formerly Les Cars Air France)
- Book a room near Montparnasse Train Station.
- Book your train ticket from Paris to Tours, from Australia well in advance to ensure you get to Tours station around 4pm on Sunday 7 January to meet the Institut Coordinator and your homestay hosts.
- Book your Tours to Paris tickets also from Australia. Homestay accommodation ends on Saturday 20 January morning.
